Supply List 2011-2012

Please note that this is a general supply list. Teachers may request a few additional items at the beginning of or throughout the school year and may ask each parent to contribute towards one or two class supplies at the beginning of the school year. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact your student's teacher. **These supplies are essential to a classroom running smoothly, so please be sure your child brings them DAILY to class!**

K4:

- ½" 3 ring binder (without zipper)
- 5 plastic colored pocket dividers for binder (labeled: Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs, Fri)
- Backpack with wheels (large enough for lunch box, school box, binder, and light sweater/jacket)
- Plastic School Box with *ONLY* the following items:
 - 3-4 pencils (Triconderoga – 3 sided pencils)
 - 1 pencil eraser
 - 8 count Twistable Crayola Crayons - primary colors
(Please note that nothing else should be kept in the school box.)
- To be kept in classroom:
 - 4 pack Dry Erase Markers
 - 24 count WASHABLE crayons
 - Child Safety Scissors
 - 1 Large glue stick
 - 4 regular sized glue sticks
 - 1 Glue Bottle
 - 1 watercolor paint set (WASHABLE IF POSSIBLE)
 - Play-dough set 3-4 primary colors
- Other expenses may include snacks, field trips, and special parties.
- Please note: some supplies may need to be replenished mid-year depending upon the number of students and materials usage.

RECOMMENDED (for home use):

- Preschool or Kindergarten Writing Tablet to practice handwriting
