



River's Edge CA General Dress Code

The River's Edge CA dress code has been carefully designed to create a positive school atmosphere for students, staff, and parents. The purpose of the dress code is *to encourage a neat, attractive appearance that will **remove distractions** and will be conducive to classroom learning. **The dress code applies not only to students, but also to parents (except no. 10) who are working their rotation duty, attending a committee meeting, working in a classroom, meeting with a teacher, or are present at the school for any reason.***

Ensure that all your young children (K4 and up) are dressed so that they can manage to go to the restroom independently with no help. Use elastic waistbands in lieu of belts, zippers, snaps, etc., if necessary.

Please review the dress code carefully with your child and model for your child the correct Christian response to authority.

1. No extreme hairstyles.
2. Boys may not wear earrings.
3. Students may wear shorts (or skorts for girls) up to 3" above the knee. No tight fitting or excessively loose fitting clothing.
4. Girls' skirts must reach the knee in length.
5. Only neat, presentable slacks and jeans may be worn. Therefore, cotton sweatpants with an elastic waistband are not suitable attire for school.
6. No T-shirts with logos, words, or screen-printed pictures except for CFC school shirts, may be worn. Collared or crew neck shirts in solids, stripes, or prints are acceptable.
7. Hats are not to be worn inside.
8. No sleeveless attire.
9. Shirts and blouses must completely cover the abdomen, back, and shoulders. No midriff should be showing during any activity.
10. Shoes must have a strap around the heel of the shoe to keep the shoe from coming off in any activity, including recess. Some recess days may require tennis shoes for the activities.

The clothing worn to school should reflect thoughtful preparation for an important activity – **learning**.
